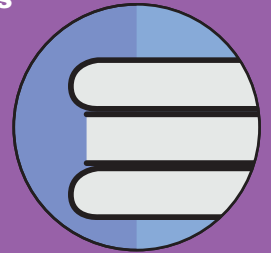

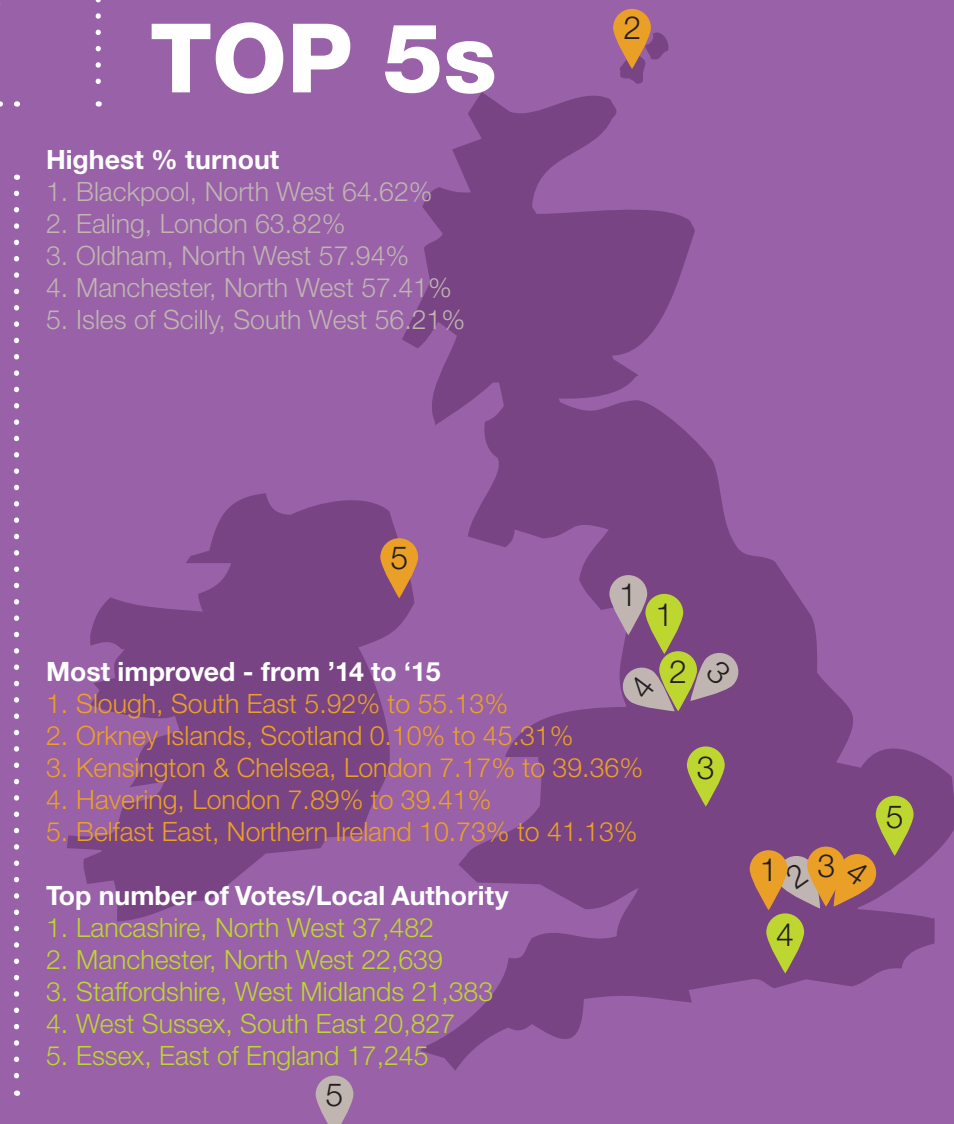

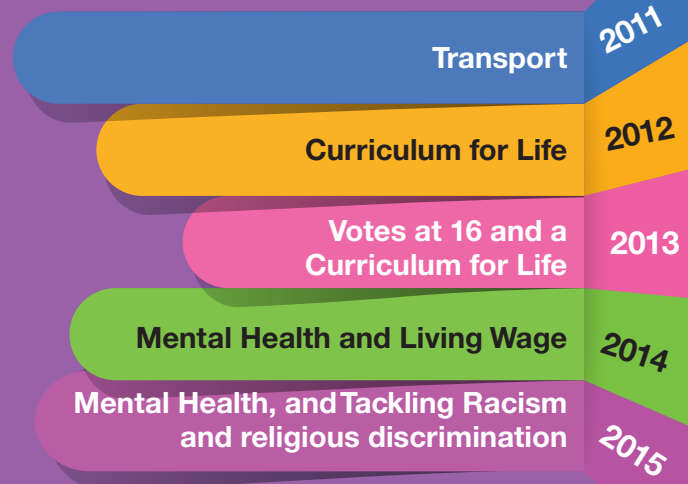

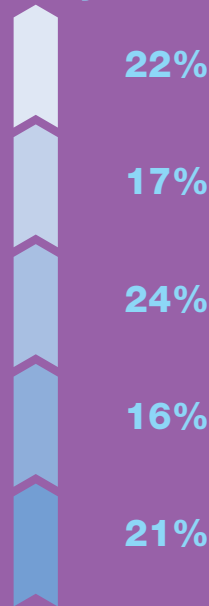

### % OF MYPs LIVING IN ENGLISH WARDS

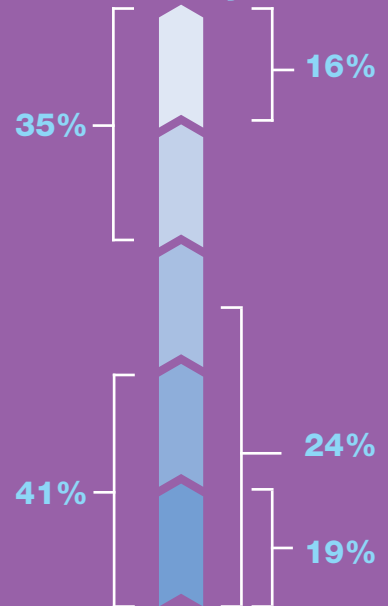
#### Most Wealthy Ward
