National Day of Action Meeting Briefing: Preparing to meet your Head of School

Meeting Aim: To promote the UK Youth Parliament's National Campaign and get permission to hold an event/take part of an assembly or lesson

Meeting Objectives (what you need to have done by the end of your meeting):

- 1) Secure a date for your event
- 2) Take a picture with your Head of school
- 3) Ask them for a quote endorsing the Campaign

Useful tips

- Take your passion with you but also make sure you read the campaign brief on why this campaign is important.
- Tell them about your meeting with your MP.
- Take a note pad with you so you can note down any important points but also to remind yourself of any key points.
- Listen with intent – allow your head of school to respond to your questions/points.
- Take your time! Take your time to make your points and respond to any questions.
- Do not doubt yourself – remember '*Never doubt that a **small group of thoughtful, committed citizens** can change the world; indeed, it's the only thing that ever has*'. There are other young people across the UK the same thing you are, you are not alone!
- As the meeting is coming to a close, briefly run through what you have discussed and what steps you are going to take to move forward.
- Be sure to take the time to thank your Head of School for agreeing to meet.
